

AIR CAP POOL LEAGUE NEWS

RECENT PLAYER ISSUES

OVER THE LAST FEW WEEKS THERE WERE 3 ISSUES THAT KEEP ARISING AND NEED TO BE ADDRESSED. ALL OF THESE PROBLEMS ARE DISCUSSED IN YOUR RULE BOOK. HERE ARE SOME OF THE SHORT ANSWERS, ALONG WITH PAGE REFERENCES IN YOUR RULE BOOK.

1. **SHOWING UP LATE FOR THE MATCH – TEAMS ARE GIVEN A 15 MINUTE GRACE PERIOD TO START A MATCH. AT 7:15 PM, PLAY MUST BEGIN, EVEN IF ONLY ONE PLAYER FROM EACH TEAM IS THERE TO START THE MATCH. SEE YOUR RULE BOOK PAGE 5, LEAGUE RULES SECTION, A. TEAM MATCHES, # 4 REGARDING MATCH START TIME AND PAGE 7, SECTION 2 & 3 REGARDING AT WHAT POINT A PLAYER THAT HASN'T SHOWN UP WILL FORFEIT A ROUND.**
2. **SLOW PLAY – EXAGGERATED SLOW PLAY WILL BE PENALIZED. PLEASE REFER TO PAGE 19, SECTION 19 IN YOUR RULE BOOK. REMINDER THE ALL TIME OUTS ARE TO BE NO LONGER THAN 1 MINUTES. WE HAVE MANY PLAYERS THAT HAVE TO GET UP EARLY TO WORK. PLEASE BE RESPECTFUL OF THIS BY BEING READY TO SHOOT WHEN IT'S YOUR TURN AND NOT TAKE EXCESSIVE TIME WHEN YOU'RE AT THE TABLE.**
3. **APPROACHING THE TABLE WHEN NOT THE SHOOTER – THIS IS ADDRESSED IN OUR LEAGUE POOL ETIQUETTE.**

In general; if you are not shooting, you should be at least 6 feet away from the table and not causing a distraction to the shooter. The opponent should not approach the table until it is their turn. That includes picking up chalk when you are not the shooter! You **should not stand beside** the table or in the line of the shooter.

Teammates are **not to approach** the table when any player is shooting to just 'look at a shot'!

Team Captains, it is your responsibility to make sure that your players conduct themselves in accordance with the rules, sportsmanship and etiquette standards set by this league.
