LEAGUE POOL ETIQUETTE

We have some new players to the league that are unfamiliar with league pool etiquette. Simply put **the shooter 'owns' the area around the table**. The opponent should not approach the table until it is their turn. That includes picking up chalk when you are not the shooter! You **should not stand beside** the table or in the line of the shooter. Teammates are **not to approach** the table when <u>any player</u> is shooting to just 'look at a shot'! Only when a time out is ACTUALLY called, is it appropriate for others to approach the table. (Or when a player requests a Referee to watch the hit.) Until then, there should be no communication of the game being played with the shooter, **including the opponent heckling (sharking) the shooter**. In general; **if you are not shooting, you should be at least 6 feet away from the table and not causing a distraction to the shooter**.

Team Captains it is your responsibility to make sure that your players conduct themselves in accordance with the sportsmanship and etiquette standards set by this league.
